There will be two mini-tests covering several sections for each chapter. Pop quizzes may be given at any time. Tests are given at the end of each chapter. Each quarter's average will be calculated as follows: homework, 20%; mini-tests , 20%; and tests, 60%. There will be a cumulative exam at the end of each semester.
