Chumash Syllabus

Welcome to Chumash class! This class is geared towards helping our students refine their skills and gain an understanding of content. Our goal this year is to complete Sefer Devarim (The Book of Deuteronomy). We will begin with Parshas Eikev (the portion of Eikev) of Sefer Devarim.

CLASS RULES:

Students **MUST** be prepared and ready to learn when the teacher walks into the classroom, or they will be penalized. Students are required to complete all homework assignments and hand them in on time.

HOW WE WILL LEARN:

All students will read through the posukim (verses) as we learn in the Chumash, and they are required to **TAKE NOTES** as we do so.

HOMEWORK:

Everyday begins with a short quiz on the material that we learned the day before. Therefore, it is the responsibility of each and every student to **REVIEW** what he or she has learned in class every night. Written work sheets will be assigned, as well.

VOCABULARY:

In order to assist our students in refining their skills in the hebrew language, students will be tested at the end of every week on a list of basic hebrew words.
