Please be certain to send enough snack each day because snacks are not to be shared.

1st Grade Supply List

- 1 - pkg of #2 pencils (no colored and no mechanical)
- 2 – first grade writing tablets
- crayons (no more than 16 per box)
- scissors (blunt tip only for 1st grade)
- 2 - 3 ring 1” binders
- 4 - pocketed folders with 3 prongs
- 2 - 8oz bottles of glue
- 2 - glue sticks (clear color)
- 1 - box of tissue
- 1 - box of baby wipes
- 1 - bottle of hand sanitizer
- 1 - zippered pencil pouch (that will hold crayons, scissors, glue stick, and pencils)
