

Rambam Day School Structured Dress Code
2026-2027
(Dress Code Applies to Pre - Kindergarten through 8th Grade)

(Please label sweaters and jackets)

DRESS CODE FOR GIRLS:

- Black skirts, jumpers, dresses, pants (length of skirts, jumpers, and dresses cannot be more than 2 inches above the knee).
Maxi skirts may be worn by 5th- 8th grade girls. The maxi skirt must be above the shoes.
- Royal blue polo shirts. Only white shells may be worn under a polo shirt.
- White or black, CREW SOCKS or KNEE SOCKS.
- Black leggings may be worn with white or black CREW socks.
- Black tights may be worn.
- Only closed shoes may be worn. Any heels may NOT be larger than one inch. The following may **NOT** be worn: **Native shoes, Crocs, Sandals, Boots, or Floafers**. If a student wears rain boots on a rainy day, they must bring closed shoes to change into before class begins.
- It is strongly suggested for K-4th grade girls to wear shorts underneath, jumpers, dresses, and skirts to keep them appropriately modest when they do cartwheels etc.
- Sweaters, light jackets, and sweatshirts are allowed to be worn in class; however, they must be black or royal blue.
- Coats may be any color.

DRESS CODE FOR BOYS:

- Black pants with belt loops.
- Belts must be worn daily.
- Royal blue polo shirts.
- Black or white socks.
- Only closed shoes may be worn. The following may **NOT** be worn: **Native shoes, Crocs, Sandals, Boots, or Floafers**. If a student wears rain boots on a rainy day, they must bring closed shoes to change into before class begins.
- Sweaters, light jackets, and sweatshirts are allowed to be worn in class; however, they must be black or royal blue.
- Coats may be any color.

During Break the Dress Code days, short shorts, miniskirts, short tops, and t-shirts with inappropriate slogans, tight fitting clothing, FLIP FLOPS, ETC. ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE. Regular shoes and socks are to be worn, and dress code basics are to be followed.

FOR DAYS THAT ARE THEME DAYS (FOR EXAMPLE PURIM DRESS UP WEEK), STUDENTS

- Are not allowed to wear costumes that depict inappropriate movies, TV shows, cartoons, books, reality TV, characters, etc.
- Are not allowed to bring any type of weapons (guns, knives, swords, etc.).
- Are not allowed to bring as a prop a cigarette, pipe, or E-Cigarettes (or like items).
- Are not allowed to wear costumes that depict gory characters/people/monsters.

We will call parents to bring structured dress code clothing for any children wearing inappropriate costumes.

Appropriate dress for school events is mandatory. Events such as: Sport banquets, Chanukah program, and 7th/8th grade play. (Examples: no t-shirts, flip flops, etc.), shirts must be tucked in.
