We have had a wonderful first week and a half of school. When I walk around and see teachers **and** students smiling; I know things are going well.

Once a child begins going to school; school becomes a very integral part of their lives. Not necessarily because they see the importance; far more so because it takes up a good part of their day. The staff of Rambam Day School wants our students to appreciate, enjoy and understand the value of going to school. For this to be accomplished, both teachers and parents must be partners.

In school, through the enthusiasm and personal attention our staff gives our students, they will realize we believe what we are doing for them is important and valuable to their futures. When we praise them and redirect them when necessary; when we applaud their successes and assure them their "failures" are just minor setbacks, and when we shower them with our love and care – we are doing our part to impress upon our students that school is a very significant part of their lives for a very good reason.

We need our parents to work with us in the following ways (not limited to):

- When dropping your child off at school and when picking them up in the AM, say goodbye, have a great day; in the PM, ask how are you? (not being on your cell phone while taking your child to school and picking them up certainly makes them feel important as you can focus on them and not sound half focused).
- After school, inquire about your child's day in a way that gives them an avenue to respond in a constructive way: "Tell me what was the best part of your day". "Tell me what part of your day did you find most challenging". When we set the stage for a positive, constructive conversation, we lead our child/dren into a real conversation and hopefully not a griping session. As well, when we ask direct questions –" How do feel you did on your math test today?" "Tell me the best part of your day". We show genuine interest. General questions like, *how was your day*, could sound like you're just making conversation.
- Have a schedule so children know when you expect them to do their HW
- Try to be available to assist with your child's HW if they need support. If you see a continuous need for support; please speak to their teacher and make them aware. It could be a real concern, or your child just needs reassurance, or they are using you as a crutch.
- Please don't wait to contact your child's teacher or the administration if you have a concern. Some concerns should be addressed immediately, and time makes a difference.
- Please address teachers respectfully and not accusingly; your child overhears more than you think. While I don't believe children should feel their feelings don't count and the teacher is always right; I do think it is crucial for children's feelings

to be validated and for them to hear from you that you believe in their teacher and there must be a "reason" and you'd like to speak to their teacher so you'll know how you can best help them (your child), because you and the teacher are partners.

I hope these tidbits help. A positive experience both at home and in school makes the experience of school a constructive one.
