



Message From the Principal:

Supportive parents may not only build happier and healthier children, but new research suggests those positive effects may last a lifetime.

"Previous studies have already shown that children who receive high levels of support from their parents report fewer psychological and physical problems. But for the first time, a new study shows that those healthy effects persist throughout adulthood." The results appear in the March issue of the journal *Psychology and Aging*.

How to be supportive:

Learn together, play together, listen when being spoken to (no phone in hand), ask open questions not yes or no questions, ask specific questions about their school day, compliment often but not to the point you sound insincere, promote positive behavior and good grades with small tokens but meaningful ones, when redirecting - speak using positive words, give hugs generously.

Our children are our most precious investments. Watch over them and do whatever it takes to **protect** your investment, do whatever it takes to help your investment **grow**.



Whichever building collects the most cans will receive doughnuts from the PTO.




Please donate canned food such as: peanut butter, jelly, canned meats, soups, canned fruit, and rice. etc. The food you donate will help local families struggling to survive.


